Hemp Market Impact Nationwide

The hemp-derived cannabinoid market in the United States generates about \$28,346,313,364 annually and supports roughly 328,067 jobs across all 50 states. The newly passed federal law could wipe out up to 95% of this market—threatening more than 311,663 jobs and over \$26.9 billion in revenue.

Congress has passed a federal spending bill that redefines hemp by capping total THC (Delta-9 + THCA) at 0.3%, banning any hemp-derived cannabinoids that are synthesized or manufactured outside the plant, and limiting THC/THCA to 0.4 mg per package. These restrictions will outlaw most hemp products—including many non-intoxicating CBD products and full-spectrum CBD oil.

The bill includes a one-year grace period before these changes take effect, meaning the ban would go into force on January 1, 2026. Without immediate action, our industry and consumer access will be devastated.
